	Call Committee: Linda reports that this conversation with the Bishop continues. Synod may have some funds available to assist our congregation with supporting a full-time pastor for a third year if we can present a proposal that shows firm support for two years plus plans for increasing dollars. Other options include a travelling or shared pastor. Our course is still uncertain. Thanks to Hergy and the other worship leaders.						
	Treasurer: Audited Financial Reports for 2019 presented. Question from the floor about what local outreach is supported. Karen explained that donors often designate givings to local outreach such as food bank, CLWR, Syrian refugees. No amount for local giving is budgeted. Suggestion that local outreach giving be announced on Sundays or in bulletin.						
	Auditors' Report: Linda Byrnes and Pat Wing reviewed all financial transactions. No concerns or questions were raised during the audit; in the opinion of the auditors, 'the books for 2019 are very clean'. New auditors will be needed for 2020.

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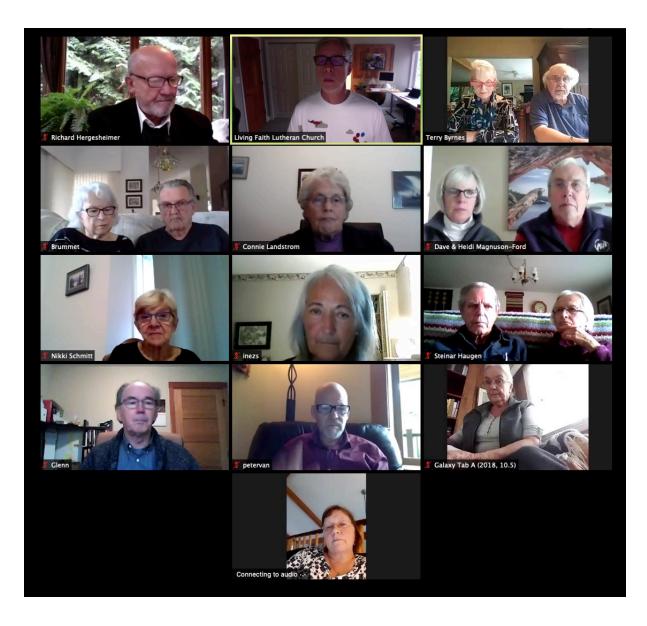
